

Potential Applications of Generated Data

- → Creative pursuits
 - Art, sketching
 - ◆ Films and animation
 - Generating captions for videos
- → Task planning
- → Generating data for training algorithms
 - ◆ Generating footage for self-driving cars
 - Generating fake user profiles to not compromise actual data




Legal Implications of Deep Fakes

- → An adversary could make fake videos of a person doing something illegal and then blackmail the party
 - ◆ Even if false, like "shouting fire in a crowded theatre"
- → Fake news could be far more convincing with conflicting stories implanted
 - ◆ Leads to less public trust in the fourth estate
- → Confirmation bias: humans are more likely to believe things that agree with views they already hold
 - If we can't trust data, we might be more willing to ignore evidence that conflicts what we want to believe

Societal Implications of Deep Fakes (1)

→ Fake election news like the Pope endorsing candidate Trump received more impressions than real election news





Ad Targeting + Deep Fakes

- → Concerns that GPT2 can be used to generate realistic text
- → This can be combined with ad targeting to manipulate public opinion.



Forgery Detection Models

- → Cat-and-mouse game just like other parts of cybersecurity
- → We can use the discriminator part of the GAN to counter the deep fakes created by the generator



President Barack Obama launched a new round of airstrikes against Islamic State in Iraq and Syria (ISIS) on Tuesday, killing at least 30 ISIS fighters and wounding more than 100 others.

The Obama administration has been bombing ISIS targets in Iraq and Syria since late last year, but the U.S. has been unable to strike the group's stronghold of Raqqa, Syria, since the group's advance into the city in June.

President Obama on Thursday announced he had authorized limited airstrikes against Islamic militants in Iraq, scrambling to avert the fall of the Kurdish capital, Erbil, and returning the United States to a significant battlefield role in Iraq for the first time since the last American soldier left the country at the end of 2011.

Speaking at the White House on Thursday night, Mr. Obama also said that American military aircraft had dropped food and water to tens of thousands of Iraqis trapped on a barren mountain range in northwestern Iraq, having fled the militants, from the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria, who threaten them with what Mr. Obama called "genocide."
